



## **New Community Information – Xenos Health**

*Xenos Health relies on personal relationships with individuals and communities to direct where our services are needed, and work through a few minor logistics.*

Xenos Health is a traveling clinic. We do not have a permanent physical location. Instead, we travel to locations where there is a need for care, and establish a temporary clinic for however many days are needed, and schedule return visits to that area depending on need as well.

***We have decided to operate this way in order to serve communities in need of natural healthcare around Saskatchewan.***

If you are interested in adding your area to our list of locations, we want to talk with you. Each community has unique needs and expectations, and the best way for us to learn these is to have a conversation with you.

We also have some needs and considerations that allow us to offer care effectively and at a reasonable cost (to both you and us). We've outlined some of these logistics below:

### **A minimum number of patients**

*The time and fuel it takes to drive to a location is a real consideration. Therefore, we do require a certain number of patient visits to make trips of various distances. Distance will be calculated from our personal residence near Humboldt, SK. There is also the possibility of coordinating coming to your location if we are already somewhere closer to your area.*

**100 km or less:** 4 patients

**100 - 400 km:** 7 patients

**Greater than 400 km:** 10 patients

- *This is certainly not the sole responsibility of one person in your community, and once we begin a conversation about coming to your area, we are more than happy to assist you with finding other interested individuals. This is usually a very simple matter of a quick social media survey, a few emails, or an announcement at a church event, or other social gathering.*

*The initial contact person/group will have the ability to schedule times before the location is available for online booking. Following their scheduling, online booking will be made available to everyone.*

**A suitable location for seeing patients**

*Most communities have some type of center, church facility, or office space available for sharing at a reasonable cost - Xenos Health will be responsible for renting the space.*

*There are a few specifications:*

- One private room which can be used for appointments
- A space that can be used as a waiting area
- Internet access
- Accessibility to community members (ie. wheelchair accessible, in-town location)
- Ideally, the location will have the coverage of a business license

**Lodging**

*Some smaller towns and villages don't have hotels or accommodations. If we will be practicing in your town two days, and staying overnight, we would ask for your help in finding suitable lodging. We do not expect this to be free, but need to know that something is available.*

**Business License**

*Regulations differ from town to town regarding the need for a business license. Ideally, a location would be chosen that already has a business license, but we are willing to communicate with chamber of commerce or equivalent committee if necessary.*

*The above are guidelines, and we are always open to working together to come up with the best plan for you and your community. Do not hesitate to contact us if you have further questions, and to start the conversation of what coming to your area could look like.*
